Because choosing a surgeon with the qualifications and an accredited clinical practice assures you safer standards of care and trusted expertise.


"Poor results from practitioners without the necessary surgical vocational training and experience is a recurring problem," explains Da Vinci's cosmetic and reconstructive plastic surgeon, Adam Bialostocki. "Anyone who isn't assured of their surgeon's experience or the reliability of the clinic they are operating in before undergoing surgery, puts themselves at risk," explains Adam.

Surgeons should perform surgery. And, here in New Zealand, the most important qualification is FRACs – Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons. Only a plastic and reconstructive surgeon

with FRACs (Plastics) is trained in cosmetic surgery. Because of this, they're the best and safest person to get advice on – and to perform – cosmetic surgery.

"Practitioners who are working outside their field do not have the depth of training and experience to deal with all aspects of a condition. When problems arise, they may not know how to deal with them safely, which can lead to an inferior outcome."

may early detection be with you!

It's been a challenging year already, but it's no time to side swipe skin essentials – especially those that could save your life.

We're talking skin cancer detection and prioritising those skin checks year-round. Unfortunately, skin cancer doesn't have a specific target market – it's not just fair skinned people at risk. Genetics, sun exposure and a weakened immune system can all play a part in triggering a new mole to erupt to the surface or prompt change in an existing lesion. Here in New Zealand, our most common skin cancer is basal cell carcinoma – which is typically slow growing – but we do have one of the highest rates of melanoma in the world –

near 2,500 new melanoma cases are reported every year. This is why we need to prioritise professional skin checks for ourselves, partners and children, and undertake regular self-checks. This means looking for changes in existing moles – crusty lesions which are tender to touch, those that are pale or waxy looking, or new lesions which appear and grow rapidly. A thorough skin check by a trained professional ensures all areas of the body are examined – the hidden ones too – insides of ears, the scalp, behind the ears, fingernails, butt cheeks, backs of legs. Staying skin aware means reducing our skin cancer numbers. So, strive on and keep up with your skin.
