Do you feel unhappy with the shape or size of your breasts?



YOU ARE NOT ALONE! Surveys regularly reveal that breast surgery is one of the most popular cosmetic procedures performed world-wide. Breast reduction (reduction mammoplasty) or breast augmentation, is performed by Mr Bialostocki at Tauranga's Grace Private Hospital. Mr Bialostocki has a special interest in breast surgery and a desire to help you achieve the result you are after. He has a wealth of experience in breast surgery, regularly performing breast reduction, augmentation, mastopexy (breast lift) and reconstruction procedures. In most cases you will need to spend one to two days in hospital post surgery. The procedures are done under general anaesthetic and because they require the wearing of post-operative surgical garments we suggest it may be more comfortable over the cooler winter months. MOHS - what is it?

STANDARD SKIN CANCER SURGERY INVOLVES EXCISION OF THE CANCER FOLLOWING WHICH YOUR WOUND IS REPAIRED.

The specimen is then sent to the laboratory and processed over a number of days. In some circumstances further surgery may then be

required if your cancer is not completely removed on the first occasion. In MOHS surgery the skin cancer is excised and then immediately examined under the microscope to ensure it has been adequately removed. As Dr Tallon is the only practicing Dermatopathologist with

International skin pathology qualifications in New Zealand you can be confident that your specimen is receiving the expert opinion it deserves. If any cancer cells remain, this area can be further excised until all the cancer is removed. The advantage of this surgery is the ability to treat your skin cancer completely in one session and provide increased assurance that it is completely removed. MOHS surgery has been shown to achieve a long-term cure rate of 99%. Should you require a reconstructive closure, as a highly skilled Cosmetic and Reconstructive Plastic Surgeon, Mr Bialostocki will be on hand to ensure you have the best outcome and minimal scarring. We are delighted to offer you this opportunity at the Da Vinci Clinic.

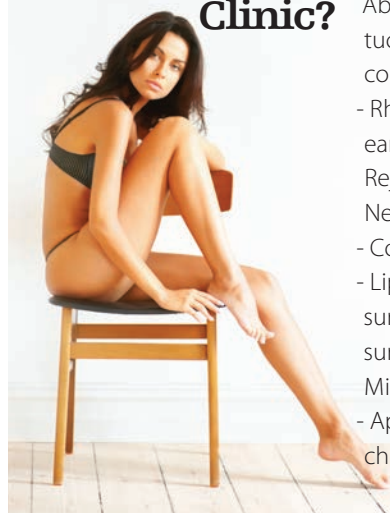


Considering an appearance medicine procedure?
